Please drive around to the back of the building to pick up your camper from 8:00 – 8:15 AM on the Saturday after the Overnighter. • If your child does not want to sleep over night, you may contact Parent Services at info@campsonshine.org to arrange for an early pick up at 9PM on Friday.
<p>Food</p>	<p>Dinner on Friday night and breakfast on Saturday are provided! We are unable to provide accomodation for special dietary needs. You are welcome to pack alternative food options for your camper.</p>
<p>What to Bring</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • An overnight bag with a change of clothes, pajamas, bathing suit and towel. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sleeping bag and pillow • Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lunch for Friday
<p>What NOT to Bring</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Personal electronics • Medications (unless prearranged through Camp Nurse) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lots of caffeinated drinks • Weapons <p>Note: Camp Sonshine is not responsible for the loss, damage, or theft of any personal property</p>
<p>Additional Information</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All High Adventure Campers are automatically registered for the Overnighter on Overnighter weeks (Weeks 2, 4, 6, 8). • Campers will not be returning to camp until 9PM. There are no alternative plans for campers that need to leave camp earlier than 9PM. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No bus transportation will be provided for Overnighter pick-up. • Campers will be sleeping INSIDE in the building at Camp Sonshine. Campers will need to provide their own sleeping bag and pillows! • If your camper needs medication administered during the Overnighter, it must be brought to the Camp Nurse by the Wednesday before the Overnighter. Please provide a physician-signed Drug Authorization Form. Campers are not to carry medication under any circumstance.
