<b>Pick-up/Departure</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pick-up will be at 9PM every Friday Evening.</li> <li>• If your child does not want to participate in the overnighter please do not send them to camp. There are no alternative plans for these time periods.</li> </ul>
<b>Food</b>	Dinner on Thursday night, as well as breakfast, lunch and dinner on Friday are provided by camp! Please be sure to pack a lunch for your camper for Thursday, or send some spending money for them to purchase a lunch.
<b>What to Bring</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• An overnight bag with a change of clothes, pajamas, bathing suit and towel.</li> <li>• Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste)</li> <li>• Lunch for Thursday</li> <li>• Spending money (optional)</li> </ul>
<b>What NOT to Bring</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Medications (unless prearranged through Camp Nurse)</li> <li>• Lots of caffeinated drinks</li> <li>• Weapons</li> </ul> Note: Camp Sunshine is not responsible for the loss, damage, or theft of any personal property
<b>Additional Information</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All Teen Adventure Campers are automatically registered for the Overnighter each week.</li> <li>• Each hotel room has two double beds. If your child does not wish to sleep on a bed with another camper, they will need a sleeping bag to sleep on the floor. Staff members will never share a bed with a camper.</li> <li>• If your camper needs medication administered during the Overnighter, it must be brought to the Camp Nurse by the Wednesday before the Overnighter. Please provide a physician-signed Drug Authorization Form. Campers are not to carry medication under any circumstance.</li> </ul>
