What is a Teen Adventure Overnighter?	Teen Adventure Overnighters are an exciting experience on select Thursday - Fridays for your Teen Adventure (7th-9th Grade) camper. Overnighters include 2 extended day out-of-town field trips and an overnight stay in a hotel. Teen Adventure Overnighters are <u>included</u> in the cost of camp on the select weeks listed below.	
What is a Teen Adventure Extended Day Trip?	On weeks where Teen Adventure Overnighters are not offered, we have Teen Adventure Extended Day Trips! The Thursday trip will be a local full day field trip that returns to camp for departure at 3:30pm. The Friday trip will be the extended day trip that will not return to camp until 8:45PM that evening. Dinner is included. There is no overnight stay on these weeks.

They only sell snack items.
What to Bring:	Overnighters: • An overnight bag with a change of clothes, pajamas, bathing suit and towel. • Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, sunscreen!) • Lunch for Thursday • Spending money (optional)	Extended Day Trips: • Bathing suit and towel. • Lunch • Spending money (optional)
What NOT to Bring:	• Medications (unless prearranged through Camp Nurse) • Lots of caffeinated drinks • Weapons Note: Camp Sunshine is not responsible for the loss, damage, or theft of any personal property. Electronic devices are strongly discouraged.	
Additional Information:	• All Teen Adventure Campers are automatically registered for the Overnighter on those select week. • If your child does not want to participate in the overnighter or Extended Day Trip please do not send them to camp. There are no alternative plans for these time periods. • Each hotel room has two double beds. If your child does not wish to sleep on a bed with another camper, they will need a sleeping bag to sleep on the floor. Staff members will never share a bed with a camper. • If your camper needs medication administered during the Overnighter or Extended Day Trip, it must be brought to the Camp Nurse by the Wednesday before the trip. Please provide a physician-signed Drug Authorization Form. Campers are not to carry medication under any circumstance.
